



## **NORDIC MARINE INSURANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMME**

### **Part-time - Intermediate level**

The Nordic Association of Marine Insurers (Cefor) offers a comprehensive Marine Insurance Education Programme aimed at professionals in the marine insurance and ship operating industries.

The objective of this pan-Nordic programme is to provide students with the basic skills necessary to do their daily job in a relevant field of marine insurance. Main focus is on practical competence. A Certificate is presented upon completion.

The programme is taught on a part-time basis over one year from August to June. The course comprises six compulsory sessions of two- and three-day seminars combining the use of lectures, individual/group exercises and class discussions.

The programme is taught by experts from Cefor member companies, with the added expertise from the Scandinavian Institute of Maritime Law and a Norwegian Average Adjuster.

Lectures are held in Oslo, Gothenburg and Copenhagen.

A Certificate of Completion will be issued to students participating in all six sessions and upon completion of a final home assignment.

## Programme outline

The programme offers a comprehensive approach to marine insurance, including:

- Business context (historic review, legal and political framework, role of marine insurance in shipping, types of cover, market conditions)
- Maritime Law (basic principles, types of liabilities)
- Marine Insurance Law (Norwegian Marine Insurance Plan of 1996 – Part I, marine insurance acts)
- Underwriting and Risk assessment (H&M, builder's risks, LoH)
- Marine claims (claims handling, salvage, adjusting, general average)
- Protection & Indemnity (IGP&I, pollution liability, personal injury liability, cargo liability, FD&D and other liabilities)
- Energy & Offshore, War Risk and Cargo Insurance
- Loss Prevention
- Reinsurance

## After attending the programme the students have achieved

- A comprehensive understanding of relevant terms and conditions in marine insurance as well as the principles behind them.
- A good knowledge of where to find them.
- Knowledge and skills to interpret them.
- An understanding and appreciation of the integrity needed to become trustworthy in marine insurance and see the total implication of this in practice.

## What is required to enter the program?

- Students should be involved in marine insurance issues through their daily work. This requirement includes employment by insurance companies, shipping companies, charterers, insurance brokers, law firms, maritime authorities and classification societies.
- Basic knowledge of marine insurance is needed through an introduction course and/or a minimum of six months work experience within the field.
- The course is recommended for insurance experts with one to three years' work experience within the field.
- Students must be able to follow lectures in English and participate in English speaking activities.
